

303 Kościuszko Squadron

303 Squadron pilots who are buried at Northwood cemetery in Middlesex were remembered on 1st September - the 303 Sqn Feast Day (Święto) - when red and white carnations were placed on their graves. Red and white flowers were also placed in the sea off Dungeness in Kent on the same day in remembrance of the 303 Sqn pilots who were lost at sea. The flowers were laid by a relative of the first British Commander of 303 Squadron, S/Ldr Ronald Kellett, and two sons of Władysław Burdziejów, one of the ground crew from its formation.
